**Creed books; manuals; and disciplines of faith? (Gal.1:8; 2 John 9,10; Rev.22:18,19).**

**B. THE CHURCH: Matt.16:18; Col.1:24; Eph.4:4.**

**Why Are There Over 1700 religious bodies? Note: John17:21; Matt.15:13; Matt.7:21,22.**

**C. BAPTISM: Mark 16:15,16; Acts 2,8,16,22.**

**The act is a burial-Col.2:12. Remission-Acts 2:38. Into Christ-Gal.3:27; Rom.6:3,4. Why do men Argue With God?**
