- A. Covetousness: Hebrews 13:5. Note: Enjoy Life/Be Thankful With What You Have. Remember: Exodus 20:17!**
- B. Envy: I Sam.18:8,9; Lk.15:25-32; I Pet.2:1; Job.5:2; Psa.73:3; Prov.14:30.**
- C. Self-Pity: “I Got Cheated In Life”; “They Are All Against Me.” Note: Remember the Prodigal Son-Luke 15.**
