## **It's Already Been Decided**

*Shepherds Notes by Lee Fisher*

Our lives are filled with many different decisions that must be made. Some, we might say, are not all that important, while others are of utmost importance. Quite often, when we are called upon to make important decisions, we do not know how to respond in order to make the proper decision. But when it comes to the major decision as to where we will spend eternity, God has already made the decision as to how we get there! People must be obedient to God's will, not their own! He made all nations and races and has given them one religion for all by establishing His kingdom (Luke 1:31-33).

This kingdom is also called the church which is in keeping with his promise *“upon this rock I will build my church”* (Matt 16:18). From the day the church was first established God has been adding to His church all those who are saved by the blood of Jesus Christ. *“Praising God and having favor with all the people. And the Lord added to the church daily those who were being saved”* (Acts 2:47). Daily they were being saved—they were being cleansed of all past sins through the blood of Christ. Peter said to them, *“Repent, and let every one of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins; and you shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit”* (Acts 2:38). It is after repentance and baptism that God will add one to the Church. Therefore, it is false doctrine to believe a person can first be saved and then later become a member of the church, the body of Christ. According to the scriptures the plan of salvation has been decided by God! The word church or kingdom is also referred to as the body of Christ. When one compares the church to the physical body, he realizes that while there are many members, there can be only one head for the one body (Col 1:18). And (Eph. 1: 22 & 23) declares that God has, *“put all things under Christ's feet, and gave him to be head over all things to the church which is his body.”* And just as the blood in our physical bodies protects us against diseases and heals our wounds, the blood of Christ is present in His spiritual body, the church, to cleanse and heal our souls. Salvation comes only through Jesus as stated in Acts 4:12. *“Neither is there salvation in any other: for there is none other name under heaven given among men, whereby we must be saved.”* God has ordained that all those who are baptized into Christ are members of His body, which is the church.

In any kingdom there are laws that must be obeyed, and yes, that has already been decided too! Notice that the First Amendment of the bill rights is a law of the land, but if we want to go to heaven, God's law has all authority in heaven and in earth. It has been provided for us in the New Testament as His only law for citizens of Christ's kingdom. The apostle Paul refers to it as the law of the spirit of life (2 Cor. 3:6). Since God's word is truth, that which disagrees with His word is false!

Decision making can become very confusing at times as we try to determine what we should, or should not do. But Gods plan is clear—we just need to believe it and obey it! Today, we should do what the men and women did in Acts (8:12). When we believe and are baptized, Jesus blood will deliver us from the power of darkness and translate us into the Kingdom of God (Col 1:13, 14). And once we are added to the kingdom and live faithful until death, we may continually enjoy the forgiveness of sin and other spiritual blessings found only in Christ.

I keep going back to the statement that will be made at judgment, found in Matthew 7. "*Lord, Lord, we did many works in your name!
