Shepherds Notes
By Boyce Edwards

DEACONS

Of the word "deacon" Vines says, "DIAKONOS, whence Eng. Deacon, primarily denotes a servant, whether as doing servile work, or as an attendant rendering free service, without particular reference to its character. The word is probably connected with the verb dioko, to hasten after, pursue (perhaps originally said of a runner)"-Expository Dictionary of New Testament Words, pg. 272.

In the N. T. it is used of domestic servants, John 2:5 & 9, civil rulers, Romans 12:3, Christ, Romans 15:8, followers of the Lord, John 12:26, Christians in their relationship to one another, Matthew 20:26, and to those who serve in the teaching and preaching of the gospel, I Corinthians 3:5; II Corinthians 3:6, Ephesians 3:6, and in I Thessalonians 3:2.

In this article, I'm dealing with the men whose qualifications are given in I Timothy 3:8-13, and who serve in conjunction with the elders of the church. Their primary work is to assist elders and serve others in the church in whatever way they can.

The "very heart" of being a Christian is to serve God and others! Those who do this are following in the steps of Jesus Christ-see the record in Matthew 20:28 & John 13:4-17. Its interesting to me to note from the parallel record in Luke 22:24 that the apostles were arguing among themselves as to who was the greatest. Apparently, the one deemed "least

greatest" was to be the "foot washer" that night! It was out of that pathetic setting that the Lord arose and girded Himself with a towel and washed the feet of the apostles! Afterwards, the Lord said in essence, *"If you don't understand by My example that you are to be servants (diakonos, vs. 26 & 27), then you cannot be My disciples!"*

One of the things that stands out in my mind in the definition given by Vines is the thought of "hastening to do service to others!"

I am very happy to say that this congregation is blessed with such men who serve as Deacons. In alphabetical order, they are: Jacob Bryant, Rey Cruz, Roger Deem, Dennis Marler, and Gaylen Williams.

If you don't know these men, please get acquainted with them! All of them are men eager to do whatever they need to do in order to help others in this congregation. Sometimes in my mind as I think of them, I see them as "running" from one job to the next to further God's cause in this congregation! That's how eager they are to serve!

They each have differing abilities and are using those for God's glorification and for the benefit of every Christian who meets at 400 North W. S. Young Drive here in Killeen, Texas.

I want to express to all these men my deep appreciation for the exemplary Christian life they are living before us all, and for their outstanding service to the Lord in this congregation!

I Peter 4:16: *"If any man suffer as a Christian, don't be ashamed; but glorify God in this behalf."*

There is no point in all this division. The Lord Jesus Christ died for us. He was raised for our justification. He will come again, and receive His own!

When someone says: "Just Who Do You Think You Are?" Just answer: "I am a blood-bought, redeemed child of God; I am a Christian!"

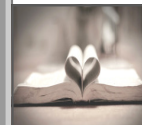
