Just Do It

Many honest, sincere, religious people believe that when a person believes, he or she at that moment is saved from sin. That is a serious concern because the Bible doesn't teach it! Yes, one must believe in order to be saved as in the record where Jesus said, "Except ye believe that I am he, ye shall die in yours sins" (John 8:24). And we have the scripture record from God that says, "And without FAITH it is impossible to be well-pleasing unto him; for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him" (Heb. 11:6). Believing that God exists is only the beginning-even the demons believe that much (James 2:19, 20)! God will not settle for merely acknowledgement of His existence! He wants FAITH that leads to a personal, dynamic, relationship!

Some people think FAITH cannot understand God and should not try. Others believe that nothing is irrational, including true faith. God gave all of us a mind that should be developed and used; but when we ignore intellectual growth, we live a stunted and naive life. When we hear the Good News we are responsible for what we've heard. Recorded in (2 Corinthians 6:1, 2), "We then, as workers together with him, beseech you also that you receive not the grace of God in vain. For he saith, I have heard thee in a time accepted, and in the day of salvation have I succoured thee: behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation." How could the Corinthian believers ignore God's message? Where they doubting Paul's words, confused by the false teachers who taught a different message? Some people heard God's message, but didn't let it affect what they said and did! How often do people IGNORE God's message over and over and over? Some people put off a VERY important decision for Christ, thinking there is plenty of time, but they could easily MISS their opportunity altogether to obey!

Christ demands that people change, and this is contrary to what many think. He did not come to save people in their sins, but he came to save people from their sins! In the inspired record, Jesus said, "Except you repent, ye shall all in like manner perish" (Luke 13:3). Unless a person is willing to turn and change from his/her sins, they will not receive salvation! But still and sadly, some will not OBEY!
