IF IT HAD NOT BEEN FOR THE LORD - Shepherds Notes by Lee Fisher

"If it had not been the Lord who was on our side," Let Israel now say "If it had not been the Lord who was on our side, When men rose up against us, Then they would have swallowed us alive, When their wrath was kindled against us; Then the waters would have overwhelmed us, The stream would have [a] gone over our soul; Then the swollen waters Would have [b] gone over our soul." Blessed be the Lord, Who has not given us as prey to their teeth. Our soul has escaped as a bird from the snare of the [c] fowlers; The snare is broken, and we have escaped. Our help is in the name of the Lord, Who made heaven and earth." (Psalm 124).

This psalm gives us a rare view into the early danger of David's kingdom, particularly from the Philistines, who had thought to see the last of Israel and end David, and the hope of Israel. In the 5TH chapter of 2 Samuel, we are shown how serious this threat was, and how little confidence David placed in his own power to survive it: so he sought counsel of the LORD! During our lifetime we may never face a wild and ruthless enemy bent on the destruction of us and our families. But we have, and will face Satan and his many angels bent on destroying our souls and our families, and we must understand that we are at war, and under attack!

Psalm 124, not only described the terrible danger that threatened Israel, but it also identified the sole reason for their survival from such a threat, i.e., "God was on their side." If we say God is on our side today, it matters not who is against us! "What then shall we say to these things? If God is for us, who can be against us?" (Romans 8:31). David wrote that the case of Israel was very dim and distressed, and no one but the Lord himself could help them. Have you ever felt that way, or needed someone to come to your rescue. God was on Israel's side then, and is still on the side of His people today! His love and concern for us causes Him to be so!

Once we obey the Gospel, we have access to all spiritual blessing that are in Christ Jesus and those good things are bestowed on us! Like Israel, God's gracious presence today supports us under all trials and temptations that come our way (1 Cor 10:13). He supplies all our wants (Phil 4:19), and keeps us by his power of his word (1 Peter 1:3-5), and preserves us from all enemies (Psalm 41:2). Yes, Christ is on our side! Now like David, we can say - "God is on Our side." And it is proper to ask the question to ourselves "If it had not been the Lord who was on our side, where would we be?" Brethren, what a great act of love God wrought upon Israel's behalf! In both the Old Testament and New Testament, much is made of The Name of God and of Jesus Christ, of which an apostle said, "Weither is there any other name under heaven, that is given among men, wherein we must be saved" (Acts 4:12).

KNOW THE LORD

"And they shall not teach every man his neighbor, and every man his brother, saying, Know the Lord: for all shall know me, from the least to the greatest"-Hebrews 8:11.

Some have read these words and been confused. They know that we are commanded to go and teach the gospel message, yet this first verse says: "And shall not teach every man his neighbor, saying, Know The Lord;" thus, confusion has arisen.

We need to understand that the writer is showing the difference in the Law of Moses for the Jewish Nation and, the New Law, under Christ.

Under the Law of Moses the Jew became a member of the Israelite Nation by Physical Birth. Then, when they were of a certain age, they were placed in school to learn the Law. They were first born, then they learned the law under which they lived, later. But, under the Gospel age, which replaced the Jewish age, one is taught first, the truth, then given the choice of either accepting it, or rejecting it. If the message of Christ (the gospel) is accepted, one then obeys the message and is thus Spiritually Born into the Family of God. Listen to the words of our Lord in John 6:45: "It is written in the prophets, They shall all be taught of God. Every man therefore who has heard and learned of the Father, comes to me."

Thus, it is clear, that under the Gospel Age, one must first be taught the truth. He is given the choice to either obey, or reject. If he accepts the truth, he obeys. He then becomes a member of the Family of God by being born again (Spiritually).

Under the Law of Moses one was physically born into the Family, then taught the Law; under the Gospel of Christ, The New Law, one is taught the truth, then is born (Spiritual) into the Family of God, the Church of Christ.

In Conclusion: It is quite clear why Christ commanded His followers to go and preach the gospel message: "Go into all the world, and preach the gospel to every creature. He that believes and is baptized, shall be saved; but he that believes not shall be condemned"-Mark 16:15,16. See that? The message is taught to the entire world! Race has nothing to do with it. Under the Old Law it was for the Jews only, and they were physically born into the Jewish Family of God. The

New Law says: "For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ, have put on Christ. There is neither Jew nor Greek; Bond nor Free; Male nor Female. We are all one in Christ"-Gal.3:27 & 28. There is now brought together all men under Christ! No longer is it better to be born a Jew than a Gentile. We are free. We are under the New Covenant. We have One Body In Christ For All Who Will Obey (Hebrews 5:8,9). Christ is now the giver of salvation to all who will obey Him.
