You Can't Do It Within Yourself - Shepherds Notes by Zack Petties

In today's life, some people may think they don't have to worry about sin because it's God's job to forgive them. Their philosophy is, "God is so loving that He won't judge; sin isn't so bad as they say because it teaches valuable lessons; we need to stay and embrace with the culture around us." The truth is, its too easy to take God's grace for granted! The scripture states in (1 John 1:8), "If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us." With God's help, and by following the principles of His word, Christians can progressively overcome sin and become more and more like Christ! God doesn't, and cannot overlook sin! No matter how many excuses people make, sinners will have to answer to God!

In Romans 7:15-22, Paul also admitted that he was carnal (Greek term, sarkinos). As a slave to the power of sin, Paul recognized that those things that he wished he could do, he could not do; and conversely, those things he knew he should not do, he found himself doing! Paul shares with us lessons learned in dealing with inward sinful desires! He also learned that self-determination (struggling in one's own strength) doesn't succeed-(7:15). Becoming a Christian does not stamp out all sin and temptation from a person's life-(7:22-25).

The old way of life before we believed in Christ is completely in the past. We should put it behind us like old clothes to be thrown away for good! If we allow these previous old ways to surface, this could devour or engulf us into abandonment from Christ! In Luke 22:31, Satan wanted to crush Simon Peter and the disciples like grains of wheat. He hoped to find only chaff and blow it away. This same desire of Satan applies to us today. Paul acknowledged that in himself alone, there was not the ability to do good-(Romans 7 chapter). He could not do the will of God for sin held dominion over him. By himself he couldn't break from sin because there was a constant warfare between the old sinful nature and his delight in the law of God. Unfortunately, today, when a Christian attempts to win that battle in only himself, he is always defeated. "Self-alone attempts" to rid indwelling sin can cause the frustration which can lure a person into going away from the Lord!

In conclusion, Christians will be faced with trials as a part of their life! Some of our problems are brought about by ours sins-(Prov. 13:15). Some difficulties come as a result of doing what is right-(2 Tim. 3: 12). But, leaning on God and being governed by His will leads us through all things, no matter how troublesome the situation may appear!

From the Desk of Dan Carter

THE LORD'S DAY

"I was in the spirit on the Lord's Day"-Revelation 1:10.

Often, we have wondered about that expression: "The Lord's Day." Through the Old Testament scriptures, the Prophets often spoke of a day that would arise. It would be a new day. It would be a time when the light of God's Glory would be seen for man's salvation.

The First Day Of The Week was always remembered by the early disciples and often spoken of by the inspired writers as the Lord's Day.

A. Christ Was Resurrected Early Sunday Morning: Matthew 28:1; Mark 16:1 & 2; Luke 24:1. A 'Mighty Angel' came down from heaven, rolled back the stone from the mouth of the tomb, and, sat upon it. The guards stationed there became as dead men.

B. The Church of Christ was established on Sunday: It was the Day of Pentecost. Pentecost came on Sunday, the day following the Sabbath. Pentecost was one of the three annual feasts under the Law of Moses. The feast came fifty days after the Sabbath following the Passover. The Jews would count seven Sabbaths, then the next day, the 50th day, Sunday, was the day of Pentecost. Read Lev. 23:15,16. Also, note Acts 2:1. Sunday was the day the Church of Christ was established.

C. This Day Marked The Beginning Of The Last Days: Often, I hear preachers say, "We are getting near the last days." These people ought to be sent back to school. They need to read their Bibles! Folks, we are living in the 'Last Days!' We have been living in the last days since the Day of Pentecost when the last message to man from God was given-"Salvation Has Come."

We have already seen that the Church of Christ-the Church Christ promised to build, was begun on the first Pentecost when the gospel of Christ was preached to the world. People responded in obedience and the Lord added to His Church those being saved (Acts 2:41, 47). Now read the words of Isaiah 2:2 & 3: "And it shall come to pass in the last days, that the Lord's House (the Church) shall be established in the top of the mountains, and exalted above the hills, and all nations shall flow unto it."

D. Sunday was the Day of Worship for the early Church: The disciples would come together, Study from

His word, Rejoice in their salvation; Sing hymns of praise to His name; Call on God through Christ in Prayer; and, Partake of the Lord's Supper. They met on the First Day of the Week (Sunday), Acts 20:7. On that day, they would make a contribution for the preaching of the message by those carrying the word, and to aid those in need-I Cor.16:1 & 2.

No wonder John referred to Sunday as the Lord's Day! Read this verse: "This is the day the Lord has made; we will rejoice and be glad in it"-Psa.118:24.
