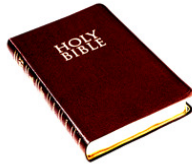

ONE DAY AT A TIME

"Let the day perish wherein, I was born"-Job 3:3. Truly, if any man had the right to complain it would have been Job. One cannot read that book and not be in sympathy with that great man of God.

Job had suffered the loss of all that was dear to him on earth, then trouble came to him physically. He lost his cherished health. He was attacked with 'boils' from head to foot. Even his wife told him to just curse God and die--but, this good man, would never do that! He said we have good things and bad things which come to the sons of God!

Well, it may be that you have suffered in a fashion as Job. In Job 5:7, we read: *"Man is born to trouble even as sparks that fly upward in the flame."* Another verse says: *"Man that is born of woman is of few days and full of trouble"-Job 14:1.*

We will always have those friends who analyze and tell us the trouble came to us because of something we did. Truly, we often bring hurt on our own selves. Foolish acts sometimes brings tragedy but there are things that happen to us simply because we live in a world of trouble. Since sin entered the picture, we have had thorns and thistles grow in our path (Genesis 3:18). Trouble comes to those who live good; and, to those who live bad.

God's people are not immune from trouble and hurts of life. One must learn to take life: "One Day At A Time!" God's man will 'meditate upon the Law of the Lord, Day and Night'-Psa.1:2.

Never has it been said: Life Is Going To Be Easy! Someone said: "We came into this world crying and, we will leave it the same way." Hang In There: *"As The Lord Suffered For Us, Leaving Us An Example, That We Should Follow In His Steps"-I Peter 2:21.*
