## From the Desk of Dan Carter

### CORRECTION IS NECESSARY

*"The rod and reproof give wisdom. Correct your son, and he shall give you rest; he will give delight to your soul"-Proverbs 29:15-17.*

Discipline is necessary in every phase of life. Without discipline all types of division, and hurt, will follow.

Scripture shows the discipline of God to those who walked disorderly. He gave warnings over and over, then He disciplined.

A child must be disciplined. The influence of evil begins at an early age. A good parent will teach; will love; and will discipline when needed.

Elders of God's people will love, lead, teach, and discipline the flock when needed. That is what a good shepherd does. He watches out for danger and alerts the flock in order to keep it from being destroyed.

There were false teachers in the early church, even as there are those today who would hurt the body of Christ. Elders must be on guard against such. False teaching must be opposed, lest it come in and destroy the body. There are many dangers from without; but, there is danger even among us from time to time.

Elders care for God's people. These men are to be honored, appreciated and prayed for, because that work is a great responsibility. They watch for our souls. They give account in Judgment for those under their care.

There can arise times when a brother, or sister, needs to be disciplined. They who would destroy the unity of God's people must be opposed. This is all to be done in love with the prayer that the member may repent and be renewed in the faith.

Paul wrote these words by inspiration: *"Now we command you brethren, in the name of the Lord*

*Jesus Christ, that you withdraw yourselves from every brother that walks disorderly, and not after the tradition you received from us"- 2 Thessalonians 3:6.*

So, if a person has to be disciplined, what should be our attitude toward the disciplined brother?

We must remember them in prayer that they repent and renounce the error; admonish them; love them, and pray that they return to the family of God. Always pray that the action of discipline has its fruit in their life, and ours.
