Brethren we had a wonderful time last week with Brother Jack Wilkie. We heard great lessons such as “Foundations -What Christian Families Need to Know to Stand Strong.” These lessons reminded us of the awesome responsibility

we have with teaching the next generation about living for God! Whether we’re thinking of our own fleshly family, or God’s family in the church, wonderful thoughts come to our mind! That’s true because the idea of the family brings pleasant thoughts to our mind, a sense of belonging, care, love, companionship, and help in times of trouble. In fact, the family structure is an age-old institution that has existed in every society, in every generation, and it is not surprising that God set up the family model in the garden of Eden when He created Adam and Eve (Genesis 1:26-28). The Church is successful when it helps every member grow to maturity and become a contributing part of the body (Ephesians 4:14-16).
