open the seals thereof: for thou wast slain,  
and hast redeemed us to God by thy blood  
out of every kindred, and tongue, and  
people, and nation:*

*And hast made us unto our God kings and  
priests: and we shall reign on the earth”*

# **I. CHRIST IS WORTHY OF OUR LOVE- Matthew 22:36-40.**

**A. Place the statement in the OT context and make application from it-all the false gods and idols.**

**B. Application by Moses in the record in Deuteronomy 6:4-7. God's people today will never be successful in passing Christianity down to the next generation without honoring this GREATEST COMMANDMENT!!**

**C. John 13:34 & 35-set in its context!**

## II. CHRIST IS WORTHY OF OUR OBEEDIENCE TO HIS WORD IN ALL POINTS!

A. John 14:15, “If you love me, ye will keep my commandments.”

B. *“And hereby do we know that we know him, if we keep his commandments.*

*He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him”-I John 2:3 & 4.*

Consider also Ecclesiastes 12:13.

### III. CHRIST IS WORTHY OF CHRISTIANS FOLLOWING HIM ON A DAILY BASIS!

A. *“And he said unto them all, If any man will come after me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow me”-Luke 9:23.*

B. *“For whosoever shall be ashamed of me and of my words, of him shall the Son of man be ashamed, when he shall come in his own glory, and in his Father’s, and of the holy angels”-Luke 9:26.*

C. Question: Are we saying, “No!” to self and following Him on a daily basis?

## **IV. THE LORD IS WORTHY OF THE FULLEST USE OF OUR TIME FOR HIM!**

**A. *“See then that ye walk circumspectly, not as fools, but as wise, Redeeming the time, because the days are evil”- Ephesians 5:15 & 16.***

**The word translated “redeeming” has the thought in it of “grabbing up bargains in a place of business!”**

**Since we can’t literally redeem time, Paul means here that Christians are to make wise use of the time that God has given us!**

**1. Doesn’t verse 18 give us a clue as to what Paul meant? There, he says, *“Be not drunken with wine, wherein is excess (riot).”***

**2. Do we as Christians think it is wise to spend dozens of hours each week watching TV?**

**3. Aren't there much better ways to use the time God gives us?**

**V. THE LORD IS WORTHY OF THE FULL USE OF OUR TALENTS-SEE THE RECORD IN MATTHEW 25:14-30, AND OTHER KINDRED PASSAGES.**

**These last 2 points are connected, are they not?**

**How can Christians fully use their talents without using their God given time wisely?**

**I think all of us can make improvements on these points, don't you?**

## **VI. THE LORD IS WORTHY OF EVERY CHRISTIAN PARTICIPATING, OR CARRYING THEIR PART OF THE LOAD, IN CHURCH ASSEMBLIES!**

**A. All Christians can assemble-Hebrews 10:25.**

**B. All Christians should use the assembly time to, “*Consider one another to provoke unto love and good works*”-Hebrews 10:24.**

**C. Doesn't verse 23 come into play here? It says, “*Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; for he is faithful that promised.*”**

**D. Consider also verses 21 & 22.**

**“*And having a great high priest over the house of God; Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water.*”**

**Aren't Christians being reminded in these verses of,  
“WORTHY IS THE LAMB?”**

**VII. THE LORD IS WORTHY OF A LIFETIME  
OF SERVICE!**

**A. Consider Paul's statement in II Timothy 4:6-8.**

**B. The Psalmist said:**

*“I love the Lord, because he hath heard my voice and  
my supplications.*

*Because he hath inclined his ear unto me, therefore  
will I call upon him as long as I live.”*

**QUESTION: Where would we as Christians be today  
without God answering our prayers? WORTHY IS  
THE LAMB!!**

## VIII. THE LORD IS WORTHY OF GROWTH IN OUR CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE LOCAL TREASURY.

*“Therefore, as ye abound in everything, in faith, and utterance, and knowledge, and in all diligence and in your love to us, see that ye abound in this grace also. For ye know the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, that, though he was rich, yet for your sakes he became poor, that ye through his poverty might be rich”-II Corinthians 8:7 & 9.*

## IX. CHRIST WAS SLAIN TO PURCHASE CHRISTIANS-REVELATION 5:9.

**A. Slain (sphazo), to slaughter, slay, as in animals for sacrifice; of Christ as The Lamb of Sacrifice!**

**B. Purchase (agorazo), to buy, to purchase, or acquire to one's self by a price duly and freely paid-see Acts 20:28.**

**Consider these words from a song (Nails) by the Boyce Edwards' Band.**

**“I was there when they nailed Him to the cross,  
Just a man in the crowd; just a soul damned to hell!  
My hands on the hammer; my heart felt the pain.  
I was there when He made not a sound.  
I was there in the crowd; just another soul He  
saved from hell!”**
