God bless each of you. Keep the Work Of Christ in your prayers. We don't intend to let anything keep us from the work of our Lord.

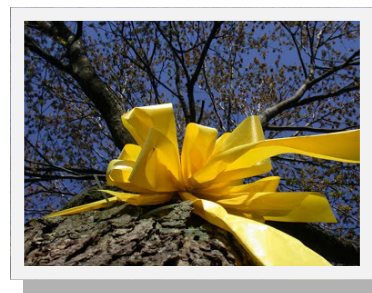

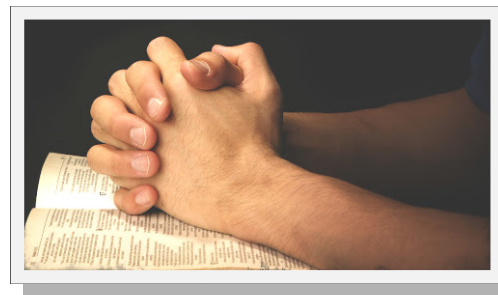
