How Some May Feel, But Still Need Teaching

Shepherds Notes By Zack Petties

In our efforts to teach the gospel, we look to Jesus Christ as our example. Colossians 1: 28 states, *"Whom we preach, warning every man, and teaching every man in all wisdom; that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus."* In today's life, some people may think they don't have to worry about sin because it is God's job to forgive them. People have made comments such as, "God is so loving that He won't judge." "Sin isn't as bad as they say because it teaches valuable lessons." "We need to stay and embrace with the culture around us." It is too easy to take God's grace for granted. The scripture states in 1 John 1:8, *"If we say we have no sin, we deceive ourselves, and the truth is not in us."* With God's help, and by following the principles of His Word, we can progressively overcome sin and become more and more like Christ. God does not and cannot overlook sin. No matter how many excuses people make, sinners will have to answer to God.

In Romans 7:14-22, Paul also admitted that he was carnal (Greek term sarkinos). As a slave to the power of sin, Paul recognized that those things that he wished he could do, he could not do, and conversely those things he knew he must not do, he found himself doing. Paul shares with us lessons in dealing with inward, sinful desires, and self-determination (struggling in one's strength), which doesn't succeed (7:15). Becoming a Christian does not stamp out all sin and temptation from a person's life (7:22-25). Our old way of life before we believed in Christ is completely in the past. We should have put it behind us like old clothes thrown away for good! If we allow these previous old ways to surface, they could engulf or devour us into the abandonment of Christ. In Luke 22:31, Satan wanted to crush Simon Peter and the disciples like grains of wheat. He hoped to find only chaff and blow it away. This same desire of Satan applies to us today! Paul acknowledged and recognized there was not the ability to do good (Romans 7). He could not do the will of God, for sin held dominion over him. By himself, he couldn't break it because it was constant warfare between the old sinful nature and his delight in the law of God. Unfortunately, when a Christian attempts to win that battle by himself alone, he is always defeated. Self-attempts to rid indwelling sin causes frustrations which can lure a person into going astray. Psalm 51:10 says, *"Create in me a clean heart, O God; and renew a right spirit within me."*

In conclusion, we will be faced with trials that are part of life. Some of our problems are brought about by our sins (Prov.13:15). Some difficulties come as a result of doing what is right (2 Tim.3:12). Leaning on God, being governed by His will, leads us through all things no matter how troublesome the situation may appear. *"These things command and teach,"* (1 Timothy 4:11). *"Whom we preach, warning every man, and teaching every man in all wisdom; that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus,"* (Colossians 1:28).
