A mystery, the gospel which is the "Good News" will have those that have abandoned the truth (1Timothy 4:1) to reconcile with a restored mind. Sadly, a report suggested that only 30% of young Americans between 21 and 37 years of age attend church. This is greatly a significant drop in church attendance and a large reason why many churches are seeing a decline in attendance. But a statistic states that 47% of non-churchgoers are open to hearing the church from friends invite. Colossians 3:23,24 states, "Whatever you do, work heartily, as for the Lord and not for men, knowing that from the Lord you will receive the inheritance as your reward. You are serving the Lord Christ." Even since creation, God has given us work to do.

When we think of personal evangelism, what is the first image that comes to your mind? The image should be an individual Christian sitting down with at least one non-Christian in a formal Bible study. We need more personal invites, evangelism, group studies, and congregational evangelism. Christians need to be recommending the church to people in their neighborhoods, communities, and possibly at their jobs. To invite others to come as the woman in (John 4:28-30) who left her waterpot to go into the city. Saying, "To see a man, which told her all things that she ever did: is not this the Christ?" Christians that make friends or guests that feel welcome and know how to deal with others impartially (James 2:1-4). Christians that are hospitable desire to spend time and getting to know them. Having a genuine interest and concern for others to invite a home study (Luke 5:27-29). Christians that follow-up with a written card, letter, email, text, and a phone call to the guest. As Paul planted (1Cor 3:6), we need those that will water who will follow-up with friends. Christians that are on the lookout for friends whom to study. You may not be the actual teacher of the study but joined with someone that is trustworthy to teach it for you. As Romans 10:14 points out, people only become Christians when people spend the time to teach them.

Imagine if we work together and commit to doing something as a group bringing visitors. But what is also so hurtful is the people that leave are ones you love, invested time with, invited to your home, and have created a friendship. Every Christian needs to be involved and be concerned with inviting friends and reaching out to those that no longer attend the service.

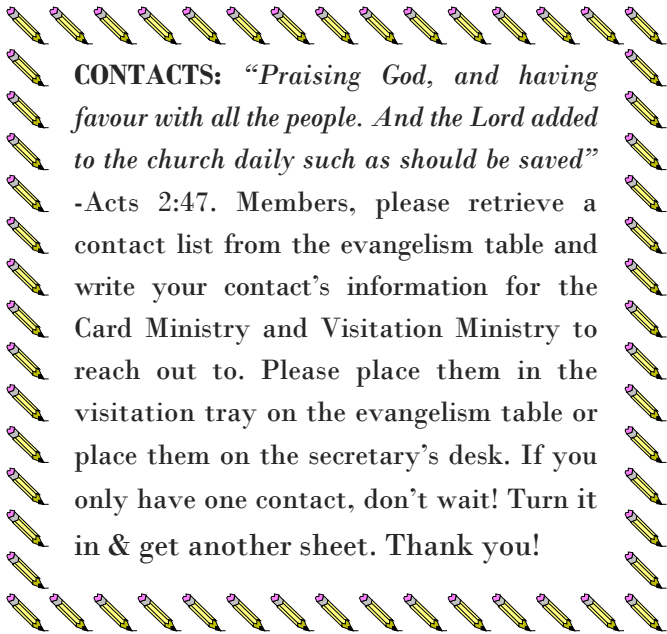
