Shepherds Notes by Zack Petties

Anyone who belongs to God listens earnestly to His words. But those that do not listen to His word do not belong to God. 2 John 1:9 states, "Whosoever transgressed, and abideth not in the doctrine of Christ, hath not God. He that abideth in the doctrine of Christ, he hath both the Father and the Son." The difference between truth and error; can distinguish one from another, discern who are the true ministers of Christ, and who are the false teachers.

For example, in the book of Jude, he urges them to defend the faith and truth avoiding those who distort the Bible to suit their own purposes.

The Truth of the scriptures points out sin, motivates us to confess our sin, renews our relationship with Christ, and guides us back to the right path. Truth is the sanctifier (John 17:17) which is to make us holy, consecrate, and set apart; this is the positive aspect of being delivered from the world. The Truth is of Christ in John 14:6, "Jesus saith unto him, "I am the way (John 10:9), the truth (John 8:32), and the life (John 1:4; 3:16); no man cometh unto the Father, but by me." But, when one enters the realm of spiritual error, we are drawn to II Timothy 4:4 "where they shall turn away their ears from the truth and shall be turned unto fables." The word of God should be a fundamentally sound teaching of the faith to be preached to the church. We should not take the body's knowledge of the word for granted! Given direct heed to the things that we hear, lest many will drift away. II Peter 1:12, 15 even Peter realizing and viewing the church/body need to be continually reminded of scripture teaching. Earlier, he wanted to awaken the complacent believers that began to listen to false teachers believing in good deeds and they could live as they choose.

So, easily members/non-members are lured and finding an attraction to listen to false doctrine that leads to spiritual error. These false teachers are simply confused due to misguided opinions and teaching that was not checked against the Bible. Jesus and the apostles repeatedly warned against false teaching (Mark 13:22, Acts 20: 29, II Thess. 2: 3-12) because it irrupts the foundation of the truth and integrity upon which Christian faith is built upon. 1 John 4:6 indicates that false teaching is becoming more popular with the world as people are home more surfing social media. As they tell people what they want to hear 1 Timothy 4:1. It was told in 1 Timothy 6:20, "O Timothy, keep that which is committed to thy trust, avoiding profane and vain babblings, and oppositions of science falsely so called:"

We must stand firm in the truth of the Good News, putting our confidence in Christ to make us right with God. Accepting what is true and rejecting what is false, avoiding every kind of evil. In 1 Thess. 5:21, we are encouraged to continue to test all things, applying Christian principles to all situations and to hold fast that which is good! Reminded, we should continue to abstain from every possible kind of evil. Neither being overcritical nor gullible to that which is unsound.

Fear has always been a part of our makeup. We fear what we see, and what we don't see. Often the scriptures speak of this trait...hear David: "I waited patiently for the Lord; and he heard my cry. He brought me up out of an horrible pit; and set my feet upon a solid rock. He put a new song in my mouth--praise unto the Lord; many will see it, and FEAR, and shall trust in the Lord. Blessed is the man that makes the Lord his trust, and respects not the proud, nor those who turn aside to lies"-Psalm 40:1-4. And here is another verse to remember: "FEAR NONE OF THOSE THINGS which you shall suffer: behold, the devil shall cast some of you into prison, that you may be tried.be thou faithful UNTO DEATH, and I will give you a crown of life"-Revelation 2:10.

We can certainly see that FEAR is the opposite of courage. We need to stand in the face of anything the devil can cast in our way..."For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places"-Ephesians 6:12! Then, he tells us to put on the armor of God that we can stand in that evil day (v.13)!

Brothers and Sisters, we are in a battle against the forces of evil. They come all the time. The devil is mad knowing that his time is short to hurt the followers of the Lord (Rev.12:12), so he makes every effort to hurt us! The main thing he uses is FEAR! He wants you to be afraid! He knows that if you are afraid, you will begin to lose your trust in the Lord! Oh, by the way, the devil is the god of this world (2 Cor.4:4); he is the prince of the power of the air (Eph.2:2), and he is our enemy (Matt.13:39)! He walks about seeking to destroy the faithful (I Peter 5:8).

Now, since we see that we have a great battle on our hands, it is not a time to be asleep or to be afraid. Listen to this verse: "Arise you who sleep; arise from the dead, and Christ shall give you light"-Eph.5:14.

Christ gives light to us! He will hold us up! Let us not fear! Remember: "Perfect Love Will Cast Out Fear"-I John 4:18! Let us not fear...let us be men and women of faith. We can do it because: "He that is in you is greater than he that is of the world"-I John 4:4!

Wasn't it the late John F. Kennedy who said: "We Have Nothing to Fear but Fear itself!" What a great statement by a man who truly loved our country.

So, let us determine that we will stand against the devil all the way. He will not destroy our faith by some plague; some word of man; or, by some miserable thing against our faith...we will not fear; we will stand strong in the Lord and in the Power of His Might! We will put on the Whole Armor of the Lord and fight against the wiles of the evil one!
