God's Fingerprints

There are physical attributes of the Almighty which are written about in the Holy Scriptures. We can read of God's hands, eyes, ears, fingers, voice, and other ways in which He has been described as having human qualities. This expression of terms is called *personification*. The Bible tells us that God is not a human; rather clearly teaching that, "*God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth*" (**Jn. 4:24**). However, perhaps because we are human and cannot fathom the way in which God Almighty actually works, we are told about God (*by God*) in a way that we can understand His actions in our world. So then, in a human sense, we cannot actually observe God's fingerprints anywhere.

From a cause-and-effect perspective though, we can witness the "fingerprints" of God on a daily basis. If one is only willing to open his (mental) eyes when he opens his physical eyes, he will see the glory of God spread across the canvas of our planet, her atmosphere, and the galaxy in which she lives. Look at the way the psalmist speaks of our world in poetic terms:

"The heavens declare the glory of God; And the firmament shows His handiwork. ²Day unto day utters speech, And night unto night reveals knowledge. ³There is no speech nor language Where their voice is not heard. ⁴Their line has gone out through all the earth, And their words to the end of the world. In them He has set a tabernacle for the sun, ⁵Which is like a bridegroom coming out of his chamber, And rejoices like a strong man to run its race. ⁶Its rising is from one end of heaven, And its circuit to the other end; And there is nothing hidden from its heat." **Psalm 19:1-6**

If one does not, cannot, or refuses to witness and acknowledge the "fingerprints" of God in the wonder that is a newborn baby, the purple and orange tinted skyline in the evening, or the majesty of a blanket dotted with millions of stars at night, he is missing out on experiencing the very Creator who lovingly made him.

Yet still there is another way to see God's "fingerprints." This is within the same realm of cause-and-effect, albeit in a different environment. This evidence of God is in the governments of the world and their relationship with their counterparts, contemporaries, and citizens. Perhaps you have voted in the past and, when your candidate won, assumed that it was the providence of God that specifically brought it about. That's possible,

we may never know. We are still so simple as it relates to God's providence. We might assume something came to happen by God and for a specific purpose, but we don't always know with any calculable certainty. There are a variety of things of which we may believe were impacted by the providence of God. Quite frequently, we might look to hindsight to grant us heightened understanding or confirmation. We might not always see God's providence in the moment (although admittedly sometimes it seems clear), but we can look *backwards* and believe with great certainty that it was God's handiwork at work in our lives or in the lives of others. We have faith that "God will provide" (**Gen. 22:8**), and we pray with such trust; though we do not always know from where God's solution will arise. It seems that an ancient pair of cousins shared that trust.

A Jewish man by the name of Mordecai lived in Persia in the 5th century BC. He was the cousin of a woman named Esther, who became queen. She was married to a king known in the Bible as Ahasuerus (**Est. 2:16-17**). This king is likely the same as one known by a different name in world history- Xerxes I (*his Greek name*), who famously fought with the Greeks and Spartans in the early 5th century battles Thermopylae and Salamis (480 BC). The king had an official who the Bible calls Haman. This man concocted a plot in a rage and was successful at convincing the king to allow an annihilation of the Jews who lived under the king's power. If this plot would have been successful, the Jews in Persia *and* in Judah would have been killed. However, the bloodline of Abraham, Jacob, and Judah had to be preserved for Jesus. Mordecai sent a message to his cousin (now Queen) Esther and appealed to her to act. Look at how he spoke of the coming danger:

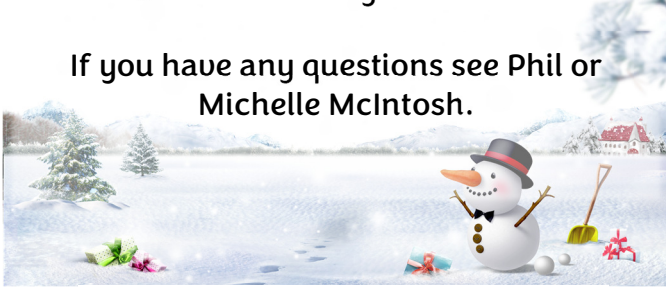
"And Mordecai told them to answer Esther: "Do not think in your heart that you will escape in the king's palace any more than all the other Jews. ¹⁴For if you remain completely silent at this time, relief and deliverance will arise for the Jews from another place, but you and your father's house will perish. Yet who knows whether you have come to the kingdom for such a time as this?" **Esther 4:13-14**

What faith in the handiwork of God! Mordecai was completely convinced that God would act, in one way or another, to preserve His promises. Mordecai acted. Esther acted. God acted. The bloodline was preserved, and our Lord became flesh from that people less than 500 years later. God is not mentioned in the book of Esther by *name*, but His "fingerprints" cover every page. God's "fingerprints" are inescapable and unmistakable in our world; one has only to want to look to find them and follow them (**Prov. 3:5-6**).
