Come With Me

One day when John the baptizer was continuing his course of teaching, thereby fulfilling his calling by God, he saw Jesus and exclaimed, "Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!" (*Jn 1:29*) John exclaimed with a similar statement the next day while two of his disciples were walking with him. As he did so, the disciples then shifted their attention over to Jesus and went with Him. However, before going to the place where Jesus was staying, the Bible tells us that Andrew first went and found his brother, Simon Peter, and invited him to come see the Messiah. Andrew essentially found Jesus and then immediately went to a family member and said, "Come with me."

Years later the "beloved physician" (as Luke is lovingly so called in *Col 4:14*) writes of a Gentile who was spoken to by God. This man was a centurion and saw a vision of an angel come to him one day and speak of the same Simon Peter. This time Peter wasn't the one coming to Jesus; this time Peter was the one who was bringing Jesus to someone else (*Acts 10:33-43*). Peter was summoned to the centurion's house in Caesarea from Joppa and, upon arrival, he found more than just Cornelius. Look:

"And the following day they entered Caesarea. Now Cornelius was waiting for them, and had called together his relatives and close friends."

²⁵ As Peter was coming in, Cornelius met him and fell down at his feet and worshiped him.

²⁶ But Peter lifted him up, saying, "Stand up; I myself am also a man." ²⁷ And as he talked with him, he went in and found many who had come together. ²⁸ Then he said to them, "You know how unlawful it is for a Jewish man to keep company with or go to one of another nation. But God has shown me that I should not call any man common or unclean. ²⁹ Therefore I came without objection as soon as I was sent for. I ask, then, for what reason have you sent for me?" -*Acts 10:24-29*

Notice that Peter had an audience waiting for him. That audience, according to Luke and the Holy Spirit, was Cornelius' "relatives and close friends" (*Acts 10:24*). That's the exact group I am encouraging you to contact.

On October 5th we, Lord willing, will meet for worship here at the church building that morning and then caravan to the church's campground in Nolanville for the next handful of hours. The temperature should be amazing that day. The food

will undoubtedly be great that day. The opportunity to reach out and impress upon our family & friends the word of God is paramount that day. Please don't miss this opportunity. Take some cards, share it on FB, ask Vicky for the image she made and send it out in some texts; do whatever you can to mention it to those whose souls are dearer to you than others because they are dear people to you, and encourage them to attend our Friends & Family Day. Let's have as many visitors as we do members that day! Invite, remind, invite again. Be like Andrew and Cornelius and bring your family to the church so they can be taught and be invited themselves to be a part of the best family that's ever going to exist- the family of Christ (*Gal 3:26-29*).
