THE STAIRWAY TO HEAVEN, PART 3, VIRTUE

Jesus said in Matthew 28:20 (New King James Version), after we are baptized, we are to be taught to, "...observe all things..." that Jesus has commanded. Our teachings after baptism are from our elders, deacons, preacher, Bible class teachers, and the other mature brothers and sisters that are faithful members of the Church of Christ, Acts 2:42-47, Matthew 13:24-30, 36-42, 1 Timothy 5, 2 Peter 3:14-18, Hebrews 5:12-6:8.

It is still our individual responsibility to develop and grow in our relationship with Christ by reading and studying the Bible. As we read and study the bible, we must actively live those principles that the Bible teaches in our current Christian Age, 2 Timothy 2:15, 2 Timothy 3:12-17, Acts 17:10-12, Hebrews 10:19-39.

In 2 Peter 1:5-11, describes the next series of steps on the stairway to heaven. Looking at verse 5, we are to add to our faith after baptism, virtue. From the Stong's King James Version, this step of virtue is listed G703, comes from the Greek language with the transliteration: arete. Pronounced: ar-et'-ay. Arete' definition is properly manliness (valor) that is excellence. The word virtue is synonymous with the word excellence. Our lives in Christ must include virtue/excellence.

We should use the life of Joseph as an example of *virtue* in Genesis 37, 39-50. Although his older brothers were jealous haters who lied to deceive their father Jacob in believing that he was attacked by an animal and dead. After being sold and trafficked into slavery, falsely accused of assaulting a master's wife, and spending time in prison, God still made a way through these struggles for Joseph to flourish with *virtue/excellence*. With emphasis on Genesis 39:1-6, if we are faithful to God, through Christ He will protect us spiritually even when the haters attack us.

If we are faithful members of the Church of Christ which is defined as faithful Christians, Acts 11:25-26, the Lord will help us keep moving forward as the haters are hating. The Lord will still make a way for faithful Christians as unfaithful Christians, and the world around us lie, cheat, steal, use and abuse, Genesis 39:21-22.

God made a way for Joseph to be the only one around with the ability to interpret the dreams of the Pharaoh, king of Egypt. With the ability to accurately interpret Pharoh's dreams, Joseph was released from prison and become what would be equal to our current Vice-President. Due to his *virtue/excellence* in what today would be a good employee/servant for Captain Potipher, refusing to commit sin with his wife, living as a model prisoner, and the accurate interpretation of the Pharoh's dreams, God protected him through all the years of trauma in his life.

Joseph is described as having performed his duties responsibly for Captain Potiphar, declining involvement with Potiphar's wife, conducting himself as a model prisoner, and providing accurate interpretations of Pharaoh's dreams. According to the Bible, these actions contributed to his protection throughout periods of hardship in his life.

Through the difficulties, trauma, and evil, let us be examples of excellence/virtue in our homes, with our family, in our places of work, and especially with the missions of the Church of Christ according to the scriptures.

We are committed to achieving the highest standards in evangelism, edification, and charitable service.

Virtue with God's help will get us through the difficulties of life on this side of eternity. With this we will shine our lights before everyone that they may see our good works and glorify the Father through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Virtue is a higher step on the stairway to heaven after baptism and being added to the church by the Lord himself, Acts 2:47, 1 Peter 1:5.
