THE STAIRWAY TO HEAVEN, PART 4, KNOWLEDGE

It is still our individual responsibility to develop and grow in our relationship with Christ by reading and studying the Bible. As we read and study the Bible, we must actively live those principles that the Bible teaches in our current Christian Age, 2 Timothy 2:15, 2 Timothy 3:12-17, Acts 17:10-12, Hebrews 10:19-39.

I realize that a lot of us do not know where and how to start reading and studying the Bible. There is so much information and guides in our world that it can be overwhelming. After 46 years as a member of the Church of Christ, I must admit that sometimes I get overwhelmed in making sure that my research sources referenced are doctrinally correct, in the correct context in accordance with the correct age of time.

The Bible as many of you already know was published and given to man from inspiration (2 Timothy 3:16-17, 2 Peter 1:19-21, 1 Peter 1:10-12) in three ages of time. The three ages of time that the Bible was written are: 1. Patriarchal Age, 2. the Mosaic Age, and 3. Our current Christian Age. According to the Scriptures, our world society is currently under the Christian Age of time. The three ages of time are better known as the Biblical Timeline. Time will not allow me to get into a study of the Biblical Timeline in this article. I can address this subject in more detail in a future bulletin article.

To assist in reducing the confusion on how to read, study, and apply the Bible, I recommend that you reference the bulletin article that I wrote published to the congregation on April 6, 2025, titled, "Additional Tools for Personal Spiritual Growth and Evangelism." In the article I recommended tool references for your spiritual library that I use to enhance, maintain, and grow to help me on the next step on the Stairway to Heaven titled, "Knowledge." I use my cell phone as a force multiplier to simplify the enhancement, maintenance, and growth of my spiritual being. We eat food the enhance and maintain our physical bodies daily for survival. While it is important to maintain the health of our physical bodies according to the Bible (1 Timothy 4:8, 1 Corinthians 3:16-17, 1 Corinthians 6:19), our Spiritual Bodies are important even more so. Our Spiritual Bodies must be fed daily with prayer, reading, studying and applying the Bible. 2 Timothy 2:15, 1 Peter 3:15, 1 Corinthians 9:27, 2 Peter 1:5-11, Galatians 5:19-26, 2 Peter 3:18, 1 Peter 2:2, Hebrews 5:12-14, 6:1-10, Matthew 6:5-15, Acts 6:4, Romans 12:12, Ephesians 6:18, Philippians 4:6, Colossians 4:2, James 5:15-16, 1 Peter 4:7, 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18.

I thank our preacher, Brother Phil McIntosh, for the series of lessons he fed us with from Brother

Kevin Rhodes book, "How to Study the Bible." I recommend that we read and study this book again along with Brother Phil's series of workbooks that supplement Brother Kevin's book. This is one of the best tools that I have in my spiritual library to enhance, maintain and grow in feeding my spiritual body See Brother Phil or myself to get access to the workbooks for this especially important spiritual tool.

Remember if we fail to eat the proper foods, nutrition, medicines, and liquids for our physical bodies daily we will become sick, weak, and even worse. If we fail to feed our spiritual bodies with daily with prayer, reading, studying and applying the Bible, we will spiritually become sick, weak, and lose our souls being separated from God in torment forever. 
