THE STAIRWAY TO HEAVEN, PART 5, **TEMPERANCE**

Temperance is defined from the Strong's Concordance, #G1466, Greek language, Transliteration: egkrateia, Pronunciation: eng-krat'-i-ah. Definition: From G1468; *self-control* (especially continence). King James Version (KJV) Usage: temperance,...2 Peter 1:6.

G1468, Greek language, Transliteration: egkrate's, Pronunciation: eng-krat-ace'. Definition: From G1722 and G2904; strong in a thing (masterful) that is (figuratively and reflexively) self-controlled (in appetite etc.): - temperate. King James Version Usage: temperate, ... Titus 1:8.

This step on the stairway to heaven is one of my weakest areas in my Christian walk. During this article, I am speaking to myself. If my self-examination during this article can help you with temperance on the stairway to heaven, we will be working together to avoid being tripped by our adversary Satan, the devil, and falling off. If we work together and be active as spiritual guard rails of encouragement and edification for one another, we can avoid the devil's attempts to trip us off this step.

I should not allow Satan to trip me up and cause a fall off the stairway. It is my individual responsibility to get up, ask whoever was harmed physically, verbally, mentally, or non-verbally through my lack of temperance. I must apologize and ask them for forgiveness. Most importantly, I should ask our siblings in Christ (my spiritual guard rails) to pray for me. I need their prayers for God's forgiveness and their encouragement to climb back up to the stairway of heaven, and continue moving up by guidance from God's Word, the Bible. Read James 5:16, 1 John 1:9, Matthew 5:38-48, 7:1-5, Romans 12:14-21, Galatians 6:1-10 James 4:6-12.

Self-control enhances my conduct as a member of the Church of God the Son (the Church of Christ). Self-control proves my faithfulness to God's Word, the Bible. Temperance/Self-control at home, at work, with non-members, during disagreements with my fellow Christians, with every thought, decision, and action. I must learn from the consequences of ungodly thoughts, decisions, and actions. What I learn from the consequences need to be repented of and resolved before leaving this side of eternity. Read Matthew 5:14-16, 27-28, 6:22-23, 16:18, 18:15-20, Acts 20:28, 2 Corinthians 4:17 Galatians 6:9, 2 Thessalonians 3:13, 2 Timothy 2:8-26, James, 1 John 1:9, Revelation 2:8-11.
